# WAY OUT WESTERN HORSE SHOWS

## General Rules- Please Read!

1. All exhibitors must sign the liability release form prior to showing. Parent or legal guardian must sign for riders under the age of 18.
2. Stallion handlers/riders must be 18 years or older. Mules, burros & donkeys are prohibited.
3. Entries will close 5 minutes before class.
4. All dogs must be leashed.
5. Schooling is allowed as long as horse & rider are eligible for the class entered. Entrants must wear proper attire, wear their number upside down, and ride non-disruptively. Entrants will not be counted as entries for points or show awards. Humane equipment only. WOW management reserves the right to excuse any entrant disrupting a class.
6. Safety-approved helmets are recommended for riders under the age of 18. Proper attire is required in all classes unless otherwise stated. Chaps are optional for ALL classes.
7. Amateur Riders - an Amateur rider is a person 19 years & older who does not accept remuneration for the following: riding, training, showing in halter, schooling, conducting clinics/seminars, or instructing. The show office may request proof of Amateur status.
8. Showmanship – To be judged on the handler with points awarded to handler.
9. Horsemanship – Pattern work required. Rail work at the judge's discretion. To be judged on rider and points given to rider.
10. The horse's age is considered as of January 1st of current year whatever age they turn during that same year.
11. The rider's age as of January 1st of the current year will be considered their show age throughout the same year.

**Show Management:** Reserves the right to itself to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to or rising out of an incident to the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions not covered by these rules and regulations shall be decided by show management and their decision shall be final. Show Management reserves to itself the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries; disqualify riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries and cancel award prizes without claim of damages; to change any course, to cancel, combine, or reschedule classes, change arenas, or rotate judges after due notice to exhibitors.

**Minor Exhibitors:** Parents or guardians of minor children shall hold Orange Park Acres-ETC, WOW Horse Shows, and members of show staff harmless from injury of such minor. No minors' entry form will be valid without a signature of parent or guardian.

**Condition of Entry:** Every horse entered for competition must abide by the rules and regulations of the horse show. The show management will in no case be responsible for condition of horses entered. Each exhibitor shall hold the Horse Show, directors and employees, WOW Horse Shows, and members of the show staff harmless for any loss or accident to his horse(s), or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire, or otherwise.

## Class Definitions

**Open-** Open to all riders with horses who are eligible for that class.

**Novice Rider-** is within first or second year of showing or not won three first blue ribbons.

**Adult Amateur-** Any rider 19 years or older as of January 1st of the current show year.

**Walk/Jog-** Any horse and rider may ride this class but may not cross-enter into a class that may ask for the lope during the course of the current show day.

**Junior Horse-** Any horse who is 5 years of age or under as of January 1st of that show year.

**Senior Horse-** Any horse who is 6 years of age or older as of January 1st of that show year.

**Country Pleasure-** Riders will be asked to ride at the walk as well as their favorite gate.

**1st & 2nd Green-** Open to any horse that is within its first or second year of showing.

**Ranch Horse Pleasure-** Class guidelines will follow those set by the AQHA.

**MINOR EXHIBITORS:** Parents or guardians of minor exhibitors shall hold the Way Out Western Horse Shows and members of the show staff harmless from injury for such minor.

**CONDITION OF ENTRY:** Every horse entered for competition must abide by the rules and regulations of the horse show but the Horse Show Management will in no case, be responsible for the condition of horses entered. Each exhibitor shall hold the Horse Show, Directors and Employees, Way Out Western Horse Shows and members of the show staff, harmless for any loss or accident to his horse(s), or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire, or otherwise. If checks do not clear the account you will be charged an additional \$25 fee. Failure to pay will result in a complete ban of the individual and the individual's horse from any future WOW show. Payment is the responsibility of the rider.

**RELEASE OF LIABILITY, INDEMINITY AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK AGREEMENT -  
PLEASE READ BEFORE SIGNING**

**In consideration for being permitted access to and use of the Mara Brandman Arena and surrounding facility and parking lot for any and all activities including but not limited to equestrian or community activities, I acknowledge and agree to the following:**

1. That I am aware and agree that horseback riding and other equine activities are athletic events which can and do involve serious risks of injuries or death to participants and spectators. I understand that my horse(s) or I may be injured or die as a result of my negligence, the negligence of others, or through no fault of myself or anyone else, because of the nature of the activity in which I am going to be engaged. I also understand that cows and horses are often unpredictable and are often difficult and sometimes impossible to control.
2. That I am aware and agree that by participating in equestrian activities, horse shows, cow sorting and related activities that I may be seriously injured by both foreseeable and unforeseeable dangers and risks;
3. That I am aware that these risks and dangers may be caused by the negligence of the owners, employees, officer or agents of OPA-ETC, JMI and its affiliates; participants, spectators and others and forces of nature that are unforeseen; and 4. That I understand and agree that by participation in activities on the property and/or use of the equipment that I assume all risks and dangers and all responsibility for any losses and/or damages to myself, my guests and any minors under my control.
5. That I further agree on behalf of myself, my personal representatives, family and my heirs, to release, waive, discharge, hold harmless, defend and indemnify OPA-ETC, JMI and its affiliates, it's owners, agents, officers and employees from any and all claims, actions or losses for bodily injury, property damage, wrongful death, loss of services or otherwise which may arise out of my use of arena and equestrian center. I specifically understand that I am releasing, discharging and waiving any claims or actions that they may have presently or in the future. This waiver is valid until revoked in writing for any and all activities that I attend on the property.

**PHOTO RELEASE** – The undersigned hereby grants to OPA-ETC, permission to take or have taken still and moving photographs and films, including television pictures, of my/our self-daughter-son-ward and consents and authorizes OPA-ETC to use and reproduce the photographs, films and pictures and to circulate and publicize the same by all means including, but not limited to, newspapers, television media, brochures, pamphlets, instructional material, books and clinical material.
